## Application for Graduate Merit Scholarship

USF allocates a limited number of Graduate Merit Scholarships to the School of Education every academic year to support research, teaching or administrative assignments for *qualified* students.

### GUIDELINES

<b>Eligibility</b>	Students must be admitted to and enrolled in the School of Education. Preference is usually given to doctoral students, but departments offering only master’s programs may nominate master’s level students. Other master’s students will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Students classified as “international” or “special status” are <i>not</i> eligible.
<b>Conditions</b>	Students need to be recommended by a School of Education full-time faculty member.
<b>Amount</b>	Successful applicants may receive a tuition grant equivalent to 3 units of course-work per academic year, disbursed usually during the fall semester. Three units correspond to a maximum of 200 hours of work. Semester substitutions, mergers and partial grants will <i>not</i> be considered.
