Immediately after the advising session, **Registration** takes place in the Parina Computer Lab, located in the UC Building, 3rd Floor. **If you have received your USFConnect user name and password/PIN, bring it with you.** It is advisable to obtain your USF I.D. card (The USF One Card) after registration. USF I.D. cards are issued by the One Card Office located in Lone Mountain, Room 130. A valid I.D. card allows access to most services available to USF students, such as the library. All MA/Credential classes begin on Thursday, August 28, 2008. In addition, during the period of 8/28 to 9/5, students may process late MA/Credential Student registrations. Saturday 8/23 is the 1st Teaching Weekend as well as Late Registration day for Doctoral Students. Students registering during this late period will be charged a \$75 late fee.
